



# Ladd School

## *Fall 2020 Remote Learning Plan*

### **Attendance**

All students must check into TeacherEase each day for attendance. Parents or students can log in with their email and password to check in. Students will only be counted in attendance if they have engaged in sessions and assignments.

### **Meals**

Meals can be ordered daily through the website. One lunch and one breakfast can be picked up each day at Ladd School or at the student's bus stop in Bureau between 12:20 and 1:20

### **Zoom**

All live instruction will be conducted via Zoom. Links for these sessions will be posted in each teacher's Google Classroom or Seesaw. If you have issues logging into your Zoom sessions you need to email your teacher.

### **COVID Symptoms**

Keeping our staff and students safe during this transition period is our top priority. Parents are responsible for checking their child daily for symptoms of COVID and should keep children home if they have any of the following: fever over 100.4, shortness of breath, chills, fatigue, headache, sore throat, nausea, diarrhea, vomiting, loss of smell and/or taste, cough or muscle aches.

### **Grading**

All traditional grading policies are in place during remote learning. Students are required to complete and submit work by the due dates assigned.

### **Return to Blended**

Ladd School Board will reassess the state of COVID-19 outbreaks in our area monthly. Any decisions to return to a blended format will be made by the BOE at that time.

## **Ladd will begin with FULL Remote Learning**

### **Remote Learning Schedule**

All classes will have daily Zoom schedules posted on our website. All students are required to attend Zoom sessions and complete all assignments daily. Students who have an issue attending the live session can watch a video upload of the instruction after 2:00 pm each day.

### **Remote Learning Platforms**

All PreK-4 grade students will be using Seesaw for all remote learning assignments and communication. 5th-8th grade students will be using Google Classroom.

### **Remote Learning Attendance**

Students are required to check in for attendance and engage in all remote learning sessions and assignments. Any student who has checked into TeacherEase for attendance but not engaged in remote learning activities will be contacted by the teacher and expected to make up the work. After two days of neglecting to engage in remote learning activities, the student will be considered absent. Please refer to the Ladd School handbook for all guidelines for attendance and truancy during remote and in person learning.
