Dear Parents and Guardians,

This afternoon, Governor Pritzker announced a mandated stay at home for Illinois residents beginning at 5 PM on Saturday, March 21 through Tuesday, April 7. The earliest school can now resume is Wednesday, April 8. There will be no school activities during the Stay at Home restriction. Track meets on March 31 and April 2 have been canceled.

We will be continuing with weekly food distribution. Free lunch and breakfast is available to all students. On Tuesday, March 24, and Tuesday, March 31, five days of breakfast and lunch will be provided. We will also distribute on Tuesday, April 7, which at this point would be just one breakfast and one lunch. Students or parents can come to pick up this food. Food cannot be eaten onsite. These meals will be distributed at Ladd School, 232 East Cleveland Street, from 8-9 at door 9. They will also be distributed at the First Congregational Church of Bureau, 101 W. Nebraska Street in Bureau Junction from 11-12.

If it is more convenient, meals could also be picked up daily at Hall High School, 800 W. Erie Street in Spring Valley from 11-12 at door 19.

Next week is our official "SPRING BREAK" so students can take a break from their daily lessons and we will resume using our learning menus on Monday, March 30. Stay at home does not mean stay in the house, so hopefully the weather will cooperate and children can get outside to go for a walk/run or play outside, but remember we still need to use social distancing and stay six feet away from our neighbors.

Wednesday, April 1 is National Census Day. Please remember to fill out your census forms while you are at home. Your numbers count for school funding!
