Winter 2021 Transition Plan

Temperature Checks

Students will have their temperatures taken at the building entrance. Students who show any symptoms of COVID or have a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be sent home.

Masks

Students and staff will be required to wear a mask at all times while in the building and on the bus. Students are required to bring masks from home.

Social Distancing

Students will maintain social distancing, remaining a minimum of 6', apart as much as possible within the building. Students will not use lockers between class periods. Students will remain in their homerooms for all classes.

COVID Symptoms

Keeping our staff and students safe during this transition period is our top priority. Parents are responsible for checking their child daily for symptoms of COVID and should keep children home if they have any of the following: fever over 100.4, shortness of breath, chills, fatigue, headache, sore throat, nausea, diarrhea, vomiting, loss of smell and/or taste, cough or muscle aches.

Self-Certification and Attendance

All students attending in-person learning must fill out a self-certification form via TeacherEase prior to coming to school. Remote learners must check-in via TeacherEase for attendance.

Increased Sanitation

Students and staff will engage in frequent hand washing, use hand sanitizer before entering and exiting the room. Increased cleaning and disinfecting of all classrooms will occur daily.

Meals

Students will not be eating at school. Grab and go lunches and breakfasts can be ordered free of charge for all students. Meals are taken home on in-person days and must be picked up on remote days.

Revised Blended and Remote Learning Options

In-Person Learning

To maximize student instructional time with the teacher in the classroom, we would like to begin phasing in whole classes. We believe it is safe to make this transition as our region is in Stage 4 with improved data, our enrollment numbers have decreased making our class sizes smaller, and vaccines are on the horizon. Our plan begins by phasing in our youngest and most dependent students. This will address academic needs as well as provide some relief to families. Phasing in ensures our procedures are adequate to handle larger attendance numbers and gives us the ability to sustain the plan if more students elect to attend in person during the third trimester

PHASE 1: All preschool students Monday-Friday 8:30-11:00 and all kindergarten students Monday-Friday 8:20-12:20 with one hour of remote instruction in the afternoon. All other grade levels continue in the red and white cohorts.

Cohort A: Families with oldest sibling's last names beginning with A-L

RED DAYS: 8:20-12:20 in the building with 1 hour of remote learning

WHITE DAYS: 5 hours of remote learning

PURPLE DAYS: 5 hours of remote learning

Cohort B: Families with oldest sibling's last names beginning with M-Z

WHITE DAYS: 8:20-12:20 in the building with 1 hour of remote learning

RED DAYS: 5 hours of remote learning

PURPLE DAYS: 5 hours of remote learning

PHASE 2: All preschool students Monday-Friday 8:30-11:00 and all kindergarten-3rd grade students Monday-Friday 8:20-12:20 with one hour of remote instruction in the afternoon. All other Grade levels continue in the red and white cohorts.

PHASE 3: All preschool students Monday-Friday 8:30-11:00 and all kindergarten-5th grade students Monday-Friday 8:20-12:20 with one hour of remote instruction in the afternoon. All other Grade levels continue in the red and white cohorts.

PHASE 4: All preschool students Monday-Friday 8:30-11:00 and all kindergarten-8th grade students Monday-Friday 8:20-12:20 with one hour of remote instruction in the afternoon.

Remote Learning Option

Ladd School will provide 100% remote learning as an option for families. Any student who chooses the remote learning option will be responsible for 5 hours of instruction/independent work and will be accountable for the same learning standards as their blended learning peers. Students choosing remote learning must commit to that option for the duration of the trimester.
